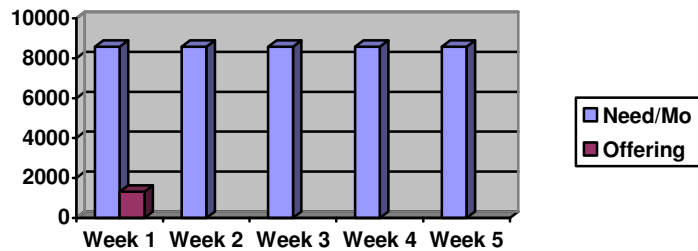
**WELCOME NEW MEMBER** Leonor Murphy, joining our church family today by Profession of Faith.

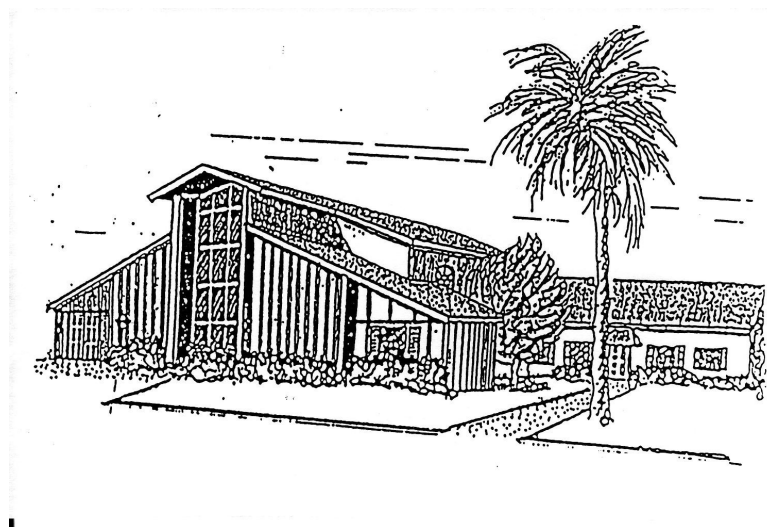
