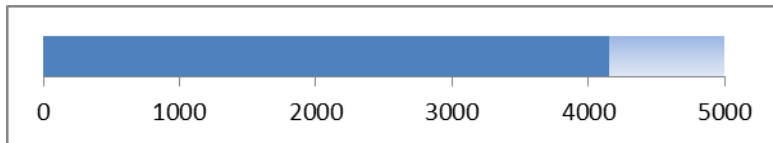

THE FLORAL ARRANGEMENT in the Sanctuary today is a love offering to God from Aldie & Jessica Garcia.

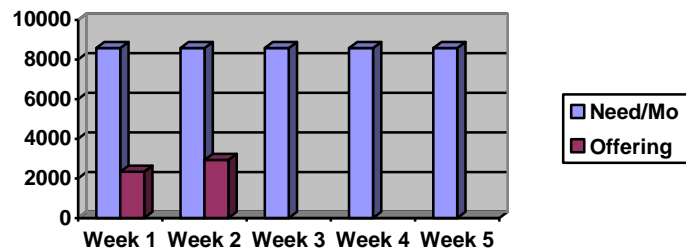

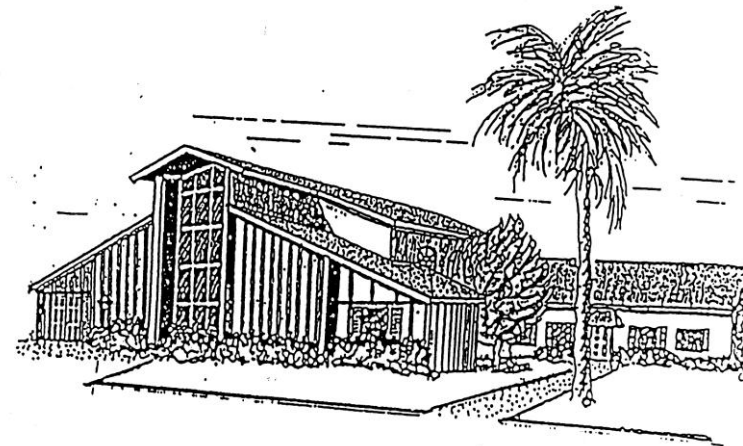
