THE FLORAL ARRANGEMENT in the Sanctuary today is a love offering to God from the Valdez family in thankfulness for Adela's birthday.

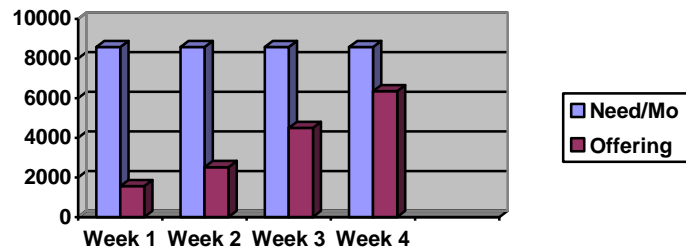
VERY IMPORTANT DEACON'S MEETING Today immediately following the worship service. All Deacons are urged to attend.

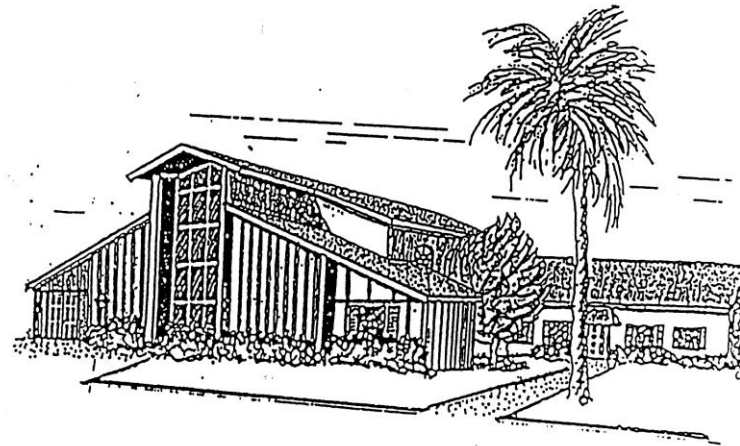
