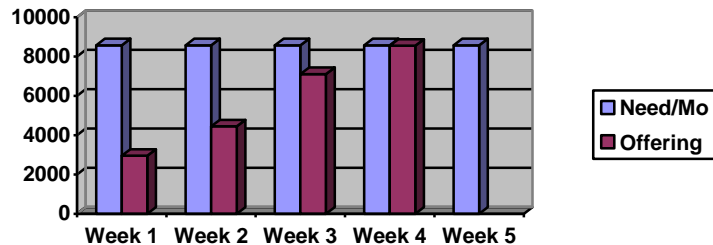

Church Budget December 2011



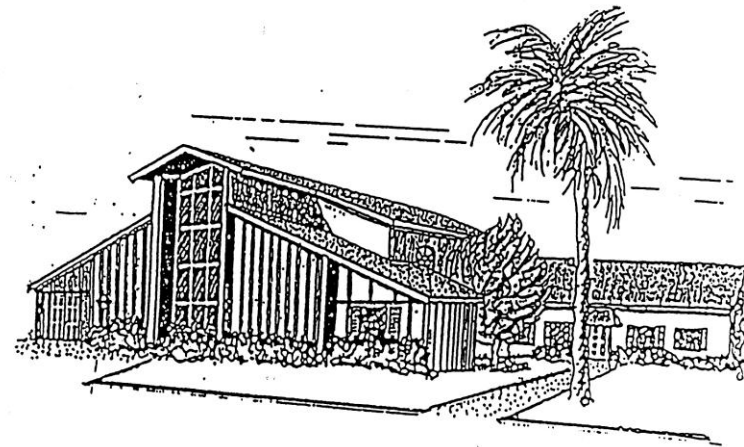
