



TODAY in our worship service, we will have a special day of prayer in support of the release of Pastor Monteiro, who has been wrongly accused for a crime in Togo, and has now been in jail for 500 days. Adventist lawyers and human rights activists have called for the men's release since they were detained in March for conspiracy to commit murder. A Tongolese man implicated Monteiro and Amah as conspirators in an alleged blood trafficking network, but a police search of Monteiro's home and local church headquarters did not produce evidence. Since then, local authorities have recognized both men's innocence.
