

#### **Legislative Alert**

SB 1146 - Oppose Thank you to all of you who have contacted your legislators. Your voices have been heard, amendments are being made to the bill but we still need your letters. . SB 1146 was voted out of the State Senate this week and now goes to the State Assembly so we need you to contact your State Assemblymembers. SB 1146 amends the California Education Code to eliminate any meaningful protection for religious colleges and universities to integrate faith into all aspects of campus life. It does so by applying broad anti-discrimination laws, including religious discrimination laws. Religious colleges may no longer be able to require faculty and students to uphold basic religious values. While the bill is vaque it appears that employment decisions could not be based on religion, except for those teaching theology and religion. This bill represents a threat to religious colleges and universities, many of which will be forced either to secularize or to shutter. What to do Now Please write a letter or email your state assemblymember. You can find out who that is at the link below and it will direct you to their web page http://findyourrep.legislature.ca.gov/ or If you have a smart phone and have already downloaded a bar code reader App simply scan the bar code below. If you do not have the bar code reader app you can download them free of charge. The one we use is the QRReader. Both options will take you to a site where you can type in your home address and press the "locate button". It will then bring up your legislators and it will direct you to their web site where you can contact them directly. All you need to write is your name, city that you live in and that you are writing to oppose SB

1146 due to unintended consequences for students and the state.

Please do not get into specifics regarding the bill as amendments

are being made on a regular basis.
