

The main project for the day will be to tear up and haul away the main sidewalk on the south side of the church.

We will have a couple jack hammers available, but will mostly need strong arms with gloved hands to carry the concrete to a dumpster.

Bring shovels to help dig up the dirt and remove as much of the tree roots as possible. We want to prepare the area to have new concrete poured the following week.

The bushes and shrubs in front of the south end of the Fellowship hall need to be removed in preparation for installing a proper drain to protect the building during heavy rains.
